Hope at Home is a hosting scheme for survivors of modern slavery and human trafficking and will train and support volunteers to welcome a survivor into their homes for an agreed time period.

- Hope at Home is looking for hosts across the UK, particularly in cities or larger towns where public transport and networks of support are available for guests. Placements are temporary and timeframes can vary from 1 month up to a year. More details attached.

They work in partnership with external agencies that provide professional support for the guest. All guests must have this support in place as well as a plan to move on from host's homes.


