

Fingerless Gloves Pattern



Abbreviations: Kfb – Knit through front and back of next stitch

Use d.k. wool and size 8 (4mm) needles

Cast on 36 stitches

Work k2, p2 for about three inches

Palm

(K9, m1 by picking up loop between stitches) repeat 3 times, K8 m1, K1 (40 sts)

P 1 row

Thumb increasing

K18 , kfb, K2, Kfb, K18 Stocking stitch three rows K18, Kfb, K4, Kfb, K18 Stocking stitch three rows

Continue increasing two more stitches in the middle of row until 10 are reached

P1 row

Divide for palm and thumb

K32 then turn.(leaving 18 stitches on left needle)

P 14 then turn

Work on these 14 stitches

St.st 2 rows

K2 P2 for 4 rows.

Cast off

Rejoin wool to the remaining 18 stitches on left needle and K to the end.

Continue working across the 36 stitches on the needles

St.st for 4 rows (you may want it to come further up to knuckles – adjust amount of rows accordingly) _

K2 P2 for about six rows (this firms up the finish on the knuckles.)
